his right closed fist. The victim again fell to the ground. The suspect then fled the location in his vehicle (Lic #7P76451) in an unknown direction.

There were no witnesses to the incident. There was no further evidence. The children were present in the home at the time of the incident, but were not in the immediate presence of the incident. The children were not interviewed.

The victim also stated that on unknown dates, within the last (2) years, on (2) occasions the suspect had physically struck her, but she did not report these incidents to police.

The victim stated that she was in fear of the suspect retaliating against her for making a police report. The victim stated that she was in fear of further physical violence from the suspect and that she was afraid that the suspect would try to take her children away from her.

We provided the victim with a Marsy's Rights card, and a business card. The victim refused a V.I.N.E pamphlet, stating that she did not wish to have any paperwork around the house that the suspect might find, which would indicate that she had filed a police report. We also offered to obtain an Emergency Protective Order for the victim and her children, which the victim also refused.

I, Officer Johnson, requested FD, and RA63, Paramedics Lee, #292086, and Mo, #306809, responded to the scene and treated the victim at scene. The victim declined transport to a hospital.

Injury/Medical Treatment

I observed a laceration on the victim's lower lip and dried blood on the victim's lips and mouth area. I also observed bruising and swelling on the left side of the victim's head, near the victim's right eye.

RA 63 responded to the scene and treated the victim's injuries. The victim declined transport to a hospital for further treatment.

Photographs

I, Officer Johnson, #40525, took (3) digital photographs of the victim's injuries. I turned the memory card into the kit room officer for processing and received D# 0413327.

Evidence

No other evidence was located.
