Agreement of the parties

- The Parties hereby withdraw the following:
    - wife's restraining order PPA Leonardo Tiberi, and
    - Husband's ex parte custody application.
  - The Parties agree to appoint Janis Laliberte as GAL of the minor child ~~XXXX~~. She shall be paid a \$5000.00 retainer in one week. Her hourly rate shall be \$350/hr. The Husband shall advance the retainer funds to attorney Laliberte.
  - Attorney Laliberte shall investigate all of the parties' claims and she shall make recommendations as to custody, access etc..
  - Until there is a hearing on the merits, the following orders shall enter relative to custody/exclusive use:
    - physical custody to the wife
    - exclusive use of 6 Birds-eye Rd Shelton to the wife
  - The Parties shall return to Court on 7/25 for a GAL report back at which time, counsel shall pick a hearing date on all financial matters, custody matters and Monetary orders comply with the Child Support and Arrearage Guidelines:  Yes  No

6. Without prejudice, the husband shall continue the financial status and as to paying all bills as has historically been the case and providing weekly support to the wife as has historically been the case.





7. The Parties shall engage the child in therapy as immediately as possible upon the recommendation of the CAZ as to who the child shall see.
