1. As a temporary order without prejudice, the Father shall have sole legal and physical custody ~~of the minor child~~ of the minor child Leonardo effective immediately. However, the ~~father~~ must confer with the mother before making any custodial decisions i.e. health, medical, school, childcare & the like. If there is a dispute, the GAC shall assist in the resolution. Either party may file a motion with the court to address any custodial decisions.

2. The mother shall immediately engage in DBT therapy with a therapist & handed in such therapy. The mother shall sign all necessary authorizations to allow the therapist to speak to the GAC. The father shall pay any cost for this therapy not covered by his ~~husband~~ ~~husband's~~ employer or IOP for DBT therapy & choose one with the ~~mother's~~ assistance of GAC. Father to pay all uninsured IOP costs.
